SUSQUENITA BLENDED CYBER PROGRAM

The Susquenita School District Blended Cyber Program (SSD Cyber) is an educational program designed to meet the needs of students who want to pursue their education in a non-traditional format.



PROGRAM HIGHLIGHTS

SSD Cyber is administered by the Susquenita School District Administration with support from the following:

- ❖ Capital Area Online Learning Association (IU 15)
- ❖ Susquenita School District principals, school counselors, support staff, and attendance officers
- ❖ An appointed cyber support teacher and cyber program providers

All SSD Cyber students are eligible for dual enrollment opportunities and are able to attend Cumberland Perry Area Vo-Tech School.

SSD Cyber courses are taken online either in school or at home, depending on the nature of the course.

Susquenita School District offers a Susquenita Diploma for all SSD Cyber students participating in our program.

Susquenita School District provides all computer equipment, textbooks, and learning material free of charge for the student to learn.

All students participating in SSD Cyber are eligible to participate in District activities such as athletics, clubs and activities, dances, class trips, scholarships, and graduation ceremony.

SSD Cyber students remain assigned to Susquenita School District for attendance reporting and mandatory state requirements.

Susquenita School District staff who is committed to the development of an individualized learning plan to meet each student's needs.

SSD Cyber students are assigned a personal advisor through Susquenita School District to help with course selections and advice for the future.
